



Nursery Home Challenges Summer 2 Week 1

Hello Nursery! Here are some challenges to keep you busy.

<p>Share the story Titch by Pat Hutchins.</p> 	<p>Find out who is the tallest/shortest in your family. Stand in height order. Draw a picture of your family in height order</p> 	<p>Can you think about you would like to do when you grow up? Can you try drawing a picture</p> 	<p>Why not try making a collage using flowers and leaves that you can find in your garden or when you go on a walk with your family.</p> 	<p>Think about things you have learnt to do. When you were a baby you could not feed yourself or walk. Ask a grown up to write down all the things you can do now. Is there something you are learning to do now? Sometimes we need to practise a new skill many times before we can do it. Ask your grown up to tell you about something they have learnt to do.</p>
<p>Physical challenge. Crouch down and jump up to make a star shape in the air spreading out your arms and legs. How many star jumps can you do? Record your score each day and see if the number changes.</p>	<p>In the Kitchen - Count the number of knives, forks and spoons in the drawer. Practical addition - How many knives and forks are there? How many forks and spoons are there? (work with numbers to 10).</p>	<p>'s' hunt! Look for items around your house that begin with the sound 's', how many can you find? Emphasise the initial sound (e.g. s-s-s-snake, s-s-s-sock, s-s-s-sausage)</p>	<p>Press spring flowers Use your press flowers or collect some things from outside, like daisies, grass, blossom and make a collage from the pieces. Collect some flowers, like daisies, buttercups and blossom. Open a book and line it with newspaper. Place your flowers (as flat as you can) on the page. Carefully close the book and weight it down - additional heavy books work well as weights. Once your flowers are dry, carefully remove them. You can then create your own flower art.</p>	
<p>Write your initial letter with natural objects or leaves. Can you you make your whole name? Sometimes easier if written first and place objects on top.</p>		<p>Make a pinwheel. See Extra Challenges Sheet of how to make one</p> 	<p>Draw your own plant growing in the plant pot.
