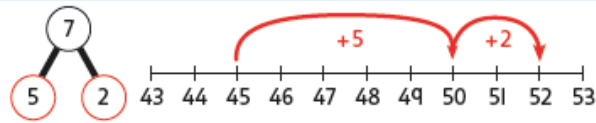
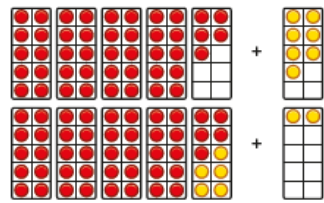


Maths skill of the week:

E.g. $45 + 7 =$

$45 + 5 + 2$
